Welcome to this first Lite Flite newsletter, which we aim to send out bimonthly. This way we would like to mark both the release of our new web site and the fine tuning of our business idea. In the last decade, Lite Flite has under grown a change from being a smaller manufacturer of interior and safety related items for aircraft, into a global supplier of helicopter rescue equipment. At the same time, we have enforced the part of our production that we are proud to call Ultrasafe Solutions.

We now have a more international observance, and customers all over the world are regarding us as a serious player in the market. This is achieved i.e. by participating at international fair shows during the last 10 years. ### The successes

Our rescue sling strop, featuring the unique self securing Triple-S system, has become standard equipment with a large number of rescue units all over the world. After just a few years, our Lite Flite Quick Release Box Mk-3 are found in Search and Rescue helicopters from north to south. The ability to open under tension is of great importance. Especially for helicopters with just a single hoist.

Denmarks new rescue helicopter EH101 is equipped with our rescue products, including the sling strop, light weight stretcher, rubber floor and other specialities.

### Everything else

Beside all this, we are manufacturing 1000's of pitot tube covers, and plugs and covers for all imaginable openings and exterior parts at both fixed wing aircraft and helicopters. Static vent covers, TAT probe, air intake, oil cooler, exhaust, propeller blade, you name it. When the pilot inadvertently turns on the pitot heat while the cover is still in place, it is nice that it is made of leather which does not melt around the pitot tube.

### Our customers

Happy customers make us happy, and we have never enjoyed so much fun as now. Our happy customers are found world wide. Our helicopter rescue equipment is in service by skilled SAR crews in 12 countries. It is fantastic to cooperate with people who know what they are talking about and what they want. This makes it nice straightforward to develop a special variation of the sling strop for specific purposes. A built in hypothermia strap ensures that chilled patients can be hoisted without problems. A solution we have developed by request from the South African Airforce rescue squadron.
